## GROUP CEO TALK

## Kunming-Vientiane Railway: When opportunity knocks on our door



In the last few weeks, people may have been hearing about the completion of a 9.5 km tunnel, the last of the 167 tunnels that are part of the Kunming-Vientiane railway line. This rail link will be connecting both travelers and goods between China and Laos, starting 2 December 2021 on the National Day of Laos.

The Kunming–Vientiane railway is part of China's Belt and Road Initiative. With a total length of over 1,000 km, it is expected to cut travel time to less than 10 hours at a train speed of 160 km/hr, compared to 30 hours previously by road. According to a World Bank forecast, by the year 2030, the shift from water to rail transport may increase freight volume to 7.6 million tons between China and Southeast Asian countries. In addition, the World Bank sees the number of Chinese tourists travelling to Laos by train increasing to 1.17 million people by 2030.

From Laos's perspective, the Kunming–Vientiane railway line is one of the most crucial projects that will transform the land-locked country into a land-linked one, and increase its chances of being a strategic center for product sourcing and distribution in the Mekong River Basin area. Aside from the Kunming–Vientiane railway project, two other major projects, the Vung Ang Port in Vietnam and the Vientiane-Vung Ang railway, are due for completion in 2023 and 2025 respectively. The former is 60% owned by Lao-Vietnam Vung Ang Port Development State Enterprise and 40% by the Vietnamese government. The latter will provide easy access via a 555 km route to the deep-sea port closest to Vientiane.

The State Railway of Thailand provides transport for passengers and goods from Nong Khai station in Thailand

to Thanaleng Station in Laos. Plans to collaborate with the private sector for a 683 km electric freight train running from Nong Khai to Laem Chabang will connect with the Kunming–Vientiane railway line to transport goods to Laem Chabang port. According to the World Bank study, transportation costs could decrease by 32% with the opening of the Laem Chabang–Kunming port route, while transport time from Thailand to China could go down to just over 20 hours, instead of several days.

While the Kunming-Vientiane railway route is set to launch in December 2021, connection to the Thai railway system is still in the early planning stages. As time is of the essence, authorities should act now so that clear guidelines can be established early on. Swift action is needed so we will be ready to seize the opportunity when it knocks on our door.

## Public Health Minister Opens Samut Prakan Ruamjai 5 (WHA) Field Hospital in Collaboration with WHART

Deputy Prime Minister and Public Health Minister Mr. Anutin Charnvirakul presided over the grand opening of the 1,300-bed field hospital Samut Prakan Ruamjai 5 (WHA), at WHA Mega Logistics Center (Chonlaharnpichit KM.4), managed by WHA Real Estate Management Co., Ltd. (WHART). This temporary site is for treatment of asymptomatic COVID-19 patients or those with mild symptoms, to control and prevent the spread of the virus.



At the opening ceremony, Mr. Anutin was joined by Mr. Wanchai Kongkasem, Samut Prakan Provincial Governor, Ms. Nantida Kaewbuasai, President of Samut Prakan PAO (Provincial Administrative Organization), and Ms. Jareeporn Jarukornsakul, Chairman and Group CEO of WHA Corporation PCL (WHA Group).

During the ceremony, Ms. Jareeporn remarked that the number of COVID-19 cases in Samut Prakan was on the rise, with both public and private hospitals running out of beds. "The two field hospitals in operation have already reached their full capacity and can no longer take in more patients. Samut Prakan authorities have been urgently looking for suitable locations to set up more field hospitals. Through the joint efforts of the Samut Prakan PAO, Samut Prakan Hospital, WHA Group and WHART, we are pleased to help establish this new facility that will treat local residents who test positive for COVID- 19 but are asymptomatic or have only mild symptoms," she said.

In line with the government's efforts to curb the pandemic, WHART is pleased to contribute to the community's wellbeing by offering one of its warehouse buildings to be used as a field hospital until 31 December 2021. With a usable area of approximately 10,000 sq.m., and the capacity for 1,300 beds, the newly-opened Samut Prakan Ruamjai 5 (WHA) at WHA Mega Logistics Center (Chonlaharnpichit KM.4) strictly follows the security and health standards set by the government and the Internal Security Operations Command (ISOC). 


